Sexualization of Children in Schools

An Attack on Innocence

The Growing Threat: Radical Agendas in Education

Today, an alarming and coordinated effort is underway to introduce radical concepts about sexuality and gender to our children—at shockingly young ages. Schools are implementing Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) programs which promote extreme ideas, such as early childhood sexual pleasure, gender fluidity, and same-sex relationships, often without the knowledge or consent of parents.

This threatens children's innocence and undermines parents' roles as primary educators.

We all want to protect our children's innocence, raise them with strong values, and guide them in a way that aligns with our beliefs.

At CitizenGO, we're fighting to give parents a voice. This e-book is here to inform, equip, and empower you to take back control of your child's education and protect them from ideologies that don't belong in the classroom.

The Consequences of Early Sexualization

Emotional and Psychological Harm: Children are taught that their gender is not determined by biology but by how they feel. They are introduced to sexual practices and concepts at an early age and encouraged to explore sexual pleasure under the premise that they have the right to do so. This can create confusion during critical stages of identity development, leading to anxiety, confusion, and potentially long-term psychological harm.

Loss of Innocence: Childhood is a period of discovery, imagination, and innocence. Exposing children to sexual content before they are developmentally prepared robs them of this valuable time and forces them to confront issues far beyond their years. Materials that introduce children, even at very young ages, to sexual content can confuse or shock them and may lead to a premature interest in sexual activities.

Learning Biological Falsehoods: A completely erroneous ideology is presented to children as fact, starting from a very young age, concerning human biology and human nature. They are led to believe that a man can become a woman and vice versa. If this biological impossibility can successfully brainwash a new generation, they can be made to believe anything in the future.

Shifting Moral and Social Values: Many CSE programs normalize behaviors that not only conflict with the values of individual parents but also undermine the century-old values of society. The goal appears to be the dismantling of these values, such as the importance and respect of family, fidelity, and the sanctity of life. These ideologies not only harm individual children but also have far-reaching consequences for society, leading to broken families and a disintegrating moral framework.

Encouragement of Risky Behaviors: By falsely teaching children that their sexual decisions are their own from a very young age and that they can do whatever they want with their bodies without parental knowledge or consent, they are exposed to risky behaviors.

Case Study: WHO's Controversial Guidelines



One of the **most alarming developments comes from the World Health Organization (WHO).**

According to their Standards for Sexuality Education in Europe, a framework for policymakers and educational authorities, **children as young as 0 to 4 years old should be introduced to concepts like “enjoyment and pleasure when touching one’s own body and early childhood masturbation.”**

For **children aged 4-6 years old**, they provide information about sexual “enjoyment” and “excitement.”

Children aged 6 to 9 should learn about ejaculation, contraception, diseases related to sexuality (STDs), “same-sex relationships”, and also “sexual intercourse”!

This depraved indoctrination envisions push-back from parents, so for 6 year-old children, they even start to teach them about naming their so-called “sexual rights of children.”

For **9 year-old children**, they push gender ideology, dissociating “differences between gender identity and biological sex”, and also so-called “sexual rights, as defined by IPPF”, which stands for the International Planned Parenthood Federation, one of the world’s biggest abortionists and abortion promoters!

And, for **15 year-olds**, the material openly promotes the so-called “right to abortion.”

These profoundly inappropriate guidelines show a lack of genuine concern for children and a blatant disregard for parental rights. While some argue that this content is merely “age inappropriate” or “premature,” it is, in reality, both **dangerous and harmful for children**.



CitizenGO on the Global Frontline

In 2018, CitizenGO hosted the groundbreaking **International Conference on Gender, Sex, and Education** in Madrid, uniting world-renowned experts to confront the harmful effects of gender ideology. Speakers like Walt Heyer, who speaks out against his own experience with transitioning, and Dr. Michelle Cretella, President of the American College of Pediatricians, presented compelling evidence on how radical gender agendas confuse children and undermine parental rights.

During the conference, we launched **The Madrid Declaration**, which boldly asserted:



“We defend the right of children not to be manipulated by gender ideology and the right of parents to educate their children freely.”

This declaration became a rallying point for those fighting to protect family values worldwide.

Since then, CitizenGO has been relentlessly pushing back against harmful CSE guidelines at the United Nations. We have consistently shown up at the Commission on the Status of Women meetings, delivering petitions, meeting with UN delegates directly, and distributing educational materials exposing the dangers of CSE.



Our presence in New York has been impossible to ignore. From eye-catching **billboard campaigns** and **banner trucks** circling the UN headquarters to **digital displays** lighting up Times Square, **we've ensured that parents' voices are seen and heard**. And our efforts have been rewarded: **we've successfully influenced policy discussions and won several key victories**, forcing harmful language out of official documents and protecting parental rights on the global stage.

Real-World Consequences: Harmful Agendas in Schools Around the World

This agenda is not isolated to one region—it's a global movement. And **CitizenGO is fighting against it across the globe.**



Austria: Shocking Sexual Content in Schools

In 2024, **Austrian students were forced to watch a graphic sex education film**, more akin to pornography than education. Confused and demoralized, many children struggled with the explicit content. In response, CitizenGO and ADF International launched a petition demanding that the government reject the WHO's harmful guidelines on sexual education. Thousands of parents united, calling for schools to respect parental rights and protect their children from such inappropriate content.



United Kingdom

Forced Participation in LGBT+ Pride

In the UK, **a young Christian boy was forced to take part in an LGBT+ Pride parade** at his school despite his parents' objections. After the family's legal challenge was dismissed, CitizenGO continued its fight to defend parental rights, ensuring that schools cannot impose controversial ideologies on children without respect for family values.

Teacher Fired for "Misgendering" a Student

Joshua Sutcliffe, **a Christian teacher in the UK, was permanently banned from teaching for refusing to use male pronouns for a transgender student**, citing his religious beliefs. A High Court judge ruled that teachers must "respect and celebrate" students' personal choices, even if these conflict with their own convictions. The decision highlights the growing pressure on educators to adopt modern gender ideologies, pushing them to compromise their beliefs in the name of compliance. Despite recent government guidance supporting the right of teachers to follow their conscience, Joshua's appeal was dismissed, reflecting a troubling trend that threatens both freedom of expression and religious rights.

CitizenGO has actively supported Joshua Sutcliffe’s fight for justice, gathering tens of thousands of signatures demanding that the UK’s Education Secretary revoke his teaching ban. Our efforts have highlighted the unjust nature of this decision and the need for policies that respect both freedom of conscience and biological reality.

Good to Know



The UK at a Pivotal Moment

With the release of the **Cass Report**, serious concerns have been raised about “**social transitions**” in schools—where students are allowed to change their **names, pronouns, clothing, and bathroom usage** without medical assessment. The report finds that children who transition socially at a young age are far more likely to follow a **medical transition pathway** later.

In response, the **Department for Education** has issued **new guidance**:

— **Schools are not obligated** to facilitate social transitions.

Single-sex spaces and **girls' sports** must be protected.

CitizenGO is actively advocating to turn these guidelines into law, ensuring that **parental rights** are upheld and **children's well-being** is protected in every school across the country.



Canada: Most alarming trends

Canada has been **aggressively pushing LGBTQ+ sensitization** across its educational system.

In 2023, Rachna Singh, the Minister of Education and Child Welfare, stated, “The month of June is a time **for all in K-12 education** throughout B.C. to hear more about Pride Month,” highlighting the government’s intent to promote these topics from the earliest grades.

This agenda extends to laws like Ontario’s Bill 89, which allows authorities to remove children from their homes if parents don’t affirm their child’s chosen gender identity.

One latest shocking case involves a young girl named Julie, whose school facilitated her gender transition without her parents' knowledge and advised her to keep it a secret. When her parents found out and objected, the school reported them to child services.

CitizenGO is actively fighting to protect parental rights and prevent schools from making life-altering decisions without parental consent, ensuring that families remain central to these critical discussions.





Germany: Indoctrination with the Genderbread Man


In Dortmund, Germany, concerned parents alerted CitizenGO after their **12-year-old son was given a “Genderbread” worksheet in biology class.**

This material, provided by the queer group “Schlau Dortmund”, promotes the idea that **gender identity is separate from biological sex**, encouraging children to question their identity during the already confusing years of puberty.

If you encounter similar content in your child’s school, alert us— together, our voice is stronger.

Outraged by this indoctrination, we teamed up with these parents to launch a petition demanding that the

North Rhine-Westphalia Ministry of Education remove such materials from schools.



Hungary: A Landmark Victory for Child Protection

In 2020, **we launched a powerful petition** in Hungary with our partners at the Human Dignity Center, demanding robust legal protections for children against inappropriate sexual content. 35,000 parents and citizens supported this call, and we delivered the demand directly to the Minister of Justice.

Shortly after, **Hungary enacted new child protection laws fully aligned with our vision, ensuring that sexualized content and gender ideology could no longer infiltrate schools without parental knowledge.**

However, international bodies like the EU and UN opposed these new laws, accusing Hungary of resisting the global push to sexualize children. Yet Hungary remained steadfast. In the 2022 national referendum, over 3.5 million citizens reaffirmed their support for these child protection measures, sending a clear message that Hungary would not abandon its values under external pressure. This was a defining moment for parental rights and family values.



Croatia: Empowering Parents to Protect Children's Innocence



"As a mother of three girls, I was shocked to learn that Croatian schools were quietly pushing harmful gender ideology on children without informing parents. To help parents take control, I co-authored the Vademecum for Parents, a guide empowering families to protect their children and demand transparency.

Later, when the Croatian government promoted the WHO's controversial sexual education guidelines, CitizenGO launched a campaign. With the support of thousands of parents, we successfully pressured the government to remove these harmful guidelines from their website.

These victories prove that when parents unite, we can protect our children's innocence and safeguard our rights."

Parental Rights Under Attack: Losing Control of Your Child's Education

One of the **most alarming aspects** of the current trend toward early sexualization is the erosion of parental rights. **Parents are being pushed aside**, as radical lobbyists and bureaucrats dictate what should be taught to their children. Increasingly, schools are making these programs mandatory, leaving parents powerless to opt their children out of lessons or materials that conflict with their family values.

But this is not a lost battle—**we have the right and the power to act and protect the innocence of our beloved and cherished children.**

Parents are the first educators of their children, and they have a fundamental right to decide what is appropriate for their children, particularly when it comes to sensitive topics like sexuality and gender identity.

Numerous international agreements affirm this right:

Universal Declaration of Human Rights Article 26 3.:

“Parents have a prior right to choose the kind of education that shall be given to their children.”

The Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union **Article 14.:**

“The right of parents to ensure the education and teaching of their children in conformity with their religious, philosophical and pedagogical convictions shall be respected.”



How You Can Protect Your Child and Take Action

At CitizenGO, we believe that **activism is the most powerful tool to restore parental rights and push back against the radical sexualization agenda.**

Stay Informed

Keep track of what's happening in your country, school district, and especially your child's school. Attend school board meetings, review curriculum materials, and ask questions.

Here you can find a sample letter you can send to your school principal requesting transparency on sensitive topics.



Request Transparency and Informed Consent

As a parent, you have the right to know what your child is being taught.

If your school plans to introduce content related to gender ideology or other sensitive issues, you

have the right to be notified and give informed consent.

If needed, document communications to create a record in case the issue escalates. Here is a sample letter to help you get started.



Organize and Advocate

Connect with other concerned parents, start meaningful conversations, and form local groups to advocate for transparency in schools. If you find harmful materials, take action by launching a petition through CitizenGO and rally your community to stand up for what's right.

CitizenGO's platform makes it easy to create a petition, build support and make a difference.

Once your petition is live, **share it widely**—with friends, family, and your local community. When you've gathered enough signatures, **deliver**

them directly to the school leadership to show the strength of parental support and demand change.

Against Christian Voices:**

Defending Faith and Freedom

For over a decade, CitizenGO has been on the front lines of defending Christians who are persecuted for their faith—from the Middle East to Africa. *But none of us could have imagined that legal harassment and silencing of Christians would become a daily reality in the so-called free societies of the West.*

Have you ever felt that simply speaking openly about your faith has become risky?

More and more Christians who stand for biblical values are being targeted, particularly through **hate speech laws, online censorship, and false accusations**. These tactics aim to silence us, but we are called to stand together.

CitizenGO Campaigners Under Attack

Our committed CitizenGO campaigners are often the targets of personal attacks, legal harassment, and public vilification. **But the support from the CitizenGO community—through prayers, protests, and financial contributions—has been overwhelming.** Together, we are making a difference.

Caroline Farrow – The Harassment of a Mother of Five

In the UK, Caroline Farrow, CitizenGO's campaign director and mother of five, **faced a traumatic police raid after being falsely accused by a transgender activist.** Police barged into her home without a warrant, confiscated her family's devices, and terrified her children—all because she dared to speak out against radical gender ideology. Caroline's story represents just one example of how Christian voices are being criminalized for simply defending the truth.



"They handcuffed me in front of my children, all for saying that men are men and women are women. My crime? Speaking the truth that men are men and women are women. It was terrifying, but through it all, I found strength in my faith. I will not be silenced."

Eduard Pröls – A Meme Can Be a Hate Crime?

Eduard Pröls, CitizenGO's campaign director in Germany, **was charged with a hate crime for simply sharing a meme on Facebook.** His experience reflects the troubling trend of criminalizing critical voices against LGBT-lobby. **Free speech is at risk** in Europe, where sharing biblical truth can lead to legal consequences.

CitizenGO launched a campaign in support of Eduard, mobilizing the Christian community to defend their right to **speak out on social media** without fear of prosecution.

The Paris Protest – Our CitizenGO Campaigners Arrested for Defending Faith

During the 2024 Paris Olympics, **CitizenGO organized a peaceful protest against the anti-Christian attacks featured in the opening ceremony.** A bus displaying the message, **“Stop Attacks on Christians!”** drove through the streets of Paris, raising awareness among thousands.

Even though we followed all the rules, by evening, French authorities decided to crack down on our peaceful demonstration. **Armed police stopped the bus, arrested six CitizenGO campaigners, and detained them in deplorable conditions.** They were held in windowless cells, denied water and food, and subjected to degrading treatment, including **forced strip searches.**

Their crime? **Defending Christian rights.**

Ironically, the police action backfired. The protest message became **even more visible** when our **Freedom Bus** was parked in front of the police station in the heart of Paris.

This shocking event sent ripples through the global

community. It was the **most severe suppression** of Christian free speech that CitizenGO had ever faced. Despite following all legal protocols, the campaigners were treated like criminals simply for defending their faith.

CitizenGO's legal team is currently preparing lawsuits against the French government, ensuring such suppression doesn't go unanswered.



“Twenty armed police officers surrounded us, and as if we were criminals, they handcuffed us. We were thrown into a dark, sweltering cell, without food or water. All of this simply because I stood up for Christianity and spoke out against the attacks on Jesus. But at that moment, Anne and I began to pray. Prayer gave us the strength to endure, to refuse to let them break us. Our faith is stronger than this oppressive act. We will not be silenced.”

CitizenGO Stands with Those Targeted for Their Faith in the Western World

The silencing and legal harassment of Christians is not limited to isolated cases—it is part of a growing trend. **Christian values are increasingly under attack**, from the **criminalization of public prayer** to the **prosecution of individuals for expressing biblical truths**. The message is clear: the world is becoming more hostile to the expression of Christian beliefs.

Matthew Grech (Malta): A Maltese singer, Matthew Grech, shared his testimony of leaving a homosexual lifestyle after finding Christ. **His story was banned from social media, and legal action was taken against him for sharing his personal experience**, allegedly promoting “conversion practices.”

CitizenGO proudly stands by Matthew, supporting his right to tell his story.

Kevin Lister (UK): A veteran teacher, Kevin Lister, lost his job for “misgendering” a female student who identified as a boy. Kevin **was fired simply for defending biological reality**. This case reveals the deeply

entrenched influence of gender ideology in education at the expense of free speech.

We are calling for strong legal protections to ensure that educators like Kevin are no longer persecuted for standing up for truth and defending biological reality.

Maureen Martin (UK): A Christian politician, running for office, **was unjustly fired from her position** at the London & Quadrant Housing Trust **after expressing her belief that marriage is between a man and a woman** in her campaign leaflet. Her employer labeled her views as “discriminatory.”

In response, CitizenGO, in partnership with Christian Concern, **has launched a petition** calling on the government to protect workers’ rights to express legally protected speech outside of the workplace without fear of losing their jobs.



Päivi Räsänen (Finland): On Trial for Sharing a Bible Verse

Imagine facing years of legal battles for simply quoting a Bible verse. This is **Päivi Räsänen's reality**. A Finnish Member of Parliament, Päivi has been subjected to relentless legal prosecution after she tweeted a passage from Romans 1:24-27 to question her church's endorsement of the Pride parade.



Alongside this tweet, prosecutors have brought up a pamphlet she authored in 2003 defending traditional marriage and a 2019 radio interview where she expressed Christian views on sexuality. **These three incidents were enough to charge her with “hate speech.”**

Although she was acquitted by lower courts, prosecutors are appealing the case to Finland's Supreme Court. If a respected politician can be put on trial for quoting the Bible, **who will be next? Pastors? Churchgoers? You?**

Päivi Räsänen's case has galvanized our global community of hundreds of thousands.

CitizenGO has been at the forefront of this fight, launching petitions, delivering signatures, mobilizing international support, and standing by Päivi's side during her court hearings .

Päivi's fight is not hers alone—it is a stand for the rights of all Christians to express their faith freely. We will continue to support her in every step of her legal journey, ensuring that no Christian is persecuted for their beliefs.



Criminalizing Prayer – A New Level of Persecution

Even silent prayer is under attack.

In the **UK, Adam Smith-Connor**, a military veteran, was fined for **silently praying** outside an abortion clinic for his deceased son, who had been aborted 22 years prior. His internal prayer was considered a crime under a new **Public Space Protection Order (PSPO)**.

Alongside ADF UK, we are supporting Adam's fight and calling for an end to this Orwellian infringement on fundamental freedoms.

If something as peaceful and personal as silent prayer can be labeled a crime, what will be next?

Similarly, Isabel Vaughan-Spruce, a pro-life charity worker, **was arrested twice for silently praying near an abortion clinic**. These so-called "buffer zone" laws not only restrict freedom of expression but also abandon women and their babies by denying them the opportunity to receive help before making a life-changing decision. These zones are increasingly being used to target Christians—even for something as private as a silent prayer.

CitizenGO's efforts, backed by tens of thousands of supporters, helped bring attention to Isabel's case, and **all charges were eventually dropped**—a victory for free speech and the freedom to pray.

The criminalization of prayer in the Western world is a stark reminder that Christianity itself is increasingly under attack. Even private expressions of faith are now perceived as a threat by governments hostile to Christian values.

Through petitions, global advocacy, and partnerships with legal organizations such as ADF International and Christian Concern, CitizenGO is mobilizing Christians around the world to stand firm against these growing threats to their right to pray and freely express their faith. **We must continue to fight to ensure that basic freedoms, like prayer and thought, are never criminalized.**



The UN's Assaults on Religious Freedom

Redefinition of Crimes Against Humanity

The United Nations is considering a **dangerous new proposal** that could **redefine “crimes against humanity” to include traditional Christian views on gender, marriage, and family**. This radical redefinition, debated in April 2024, would align international law with extreme gender ideologies, threatening to criminalize millions who uphold these beliefs.

If adopted, the amendments would erase the long-established biological definition of male and female from the Rome Statute, potentially turning basic convictions about gender and life into prosecutable offenses. Under these changes, religious leaders could be prosecuted simply for preaching biblical truths, and parents could face legal action for protecting their children from harmful ideologies.

CitizenGO has launched a global campaign to resist this assault on faith and freedom. Our petition, signed by over 2.4 million people, calls on world leaders to stand against this unprecedented attack and preserve

the right to freely express traditional values.

If we don't act now, the very principles that define free societies could be redefined and suppressed by a new global standard that criminalizes our core beliefs.



The UN's Direct Attack on Religious Institutions

In June 2024, **a report was presented** at the 53rd UN Human Rights Council **which targeted religious institutions directly, arguing that Christian teachings on marriage and family are incompatible with so-called "LGBTQ+ rights."** The report recommended that governments intervene in religious practices to enforce so-called "LGBTQ+ norms," which could result in religious leaders being forced to perform same-sex marriages or face severe legal penalties.

This proposal also outlined plans for governments to monitor and regulate religious practices, penalizing

churches and organizations that refuse to conform.

This is not just a hypothetical concern—it is an unfolding reality that threatens the very essence of religious freedom.

CitizenGO is fighting back by rallying Christians across the globe through petitions and campaigns, gathering hundreds of thousands of signatures to reject this unprecedented assault on our Christian faith.



Conclusion: We Cannot Remain Silent

The arrests in Paris and the ongoing legal battles across the West symbolize the growing global war on Christian free speech. **CitizenGO is leading the charge to protect religious freedom and free speech.** But we cannot win this fight alone.

This chapter captures the fight **you** were a part of, alongside **2.5 million people** worldwide. Together, we resisted the overreach of unelected authorities, sharing victories, key moments of resistance, and tireless efforts to protect our freedoms.

From Geneva to Berlin, **your voice** was heard. Together, we made an impact—and together, we will keep fighting for the future of our democracies.



The Turning Point: CitizenGO Takes a Stand

In early 2023, as the world focused on post-pandemic recovery, something more insidious was happening behind the scenes. The **WHO** was accelerating discussions on a new Pandemic Treaty, a document that could give this global body the unilateral power to declare health emergencies and enforce mandates, without regard to personal freedom and national sovereignty.

But **CitizenGO** recognized the danger before most. We saw the potential threat to **freedom, democracy, and national autonomy**—and we knew we had to act fast. By **April 2023**, we launched a bold, global campaign to stop the treaty in its tracks.

What happened next was extraordinary: thanks to **your** support, our movement caught fire. Activists from over **20 countries** mobilized, and within just days, **hundreds of thousands** of people stood up with us. Governments took notice—the pressure was building. This movement, fueled by the passion of millions, was simply too powerful to ignore.

Key Concerns Regarding the WHO Pandemic Treaty

Understanding the major threats posed by the WHO Pandemic Treaty is essential. Here are the key points to consider:

Erosion of National Sovereignty

The treaty gives the WHO the power to **control national policies** on health, doctors, hospitals, and health-related decision-making.

Concentration of Power

This treaty shifts critical health decisions to an unelected body. Influenced by private donors, lobbyists, and pharmaceutical companies, the WHO could override national governments, enforcing vaccine mandates, lockdowns, and surveillance measures without local accountability.

Threat to Personal Freedoms

The WHO could enforce restrictions, like lockdowns, mandatory vaccinations, limiting personal freedom to decide on our health choices and also the national governments' ability to respond based on local needs.

Potential Health Emergencies

The WHO would have the authority to **declare global health emergencies** without national consent, gaining immediate control over our lives and economies.

Global Surveillance & Privacy Risks

Centralizing health data under WHO control raises privacy concerns, with risks of misuse that could infringe on individual and national security.

Combating “Misinformation”

This power could **suppress dissent** and open debate by fighting so-called “misinformation,” silencing those who stand up for freedom and question the global authority.



A Global Force for Change: Uniting Voices from Around the World

As the pivotal **76th World Health Assembly** approached in May 2023, where the draft Pandemic Treaty was to be unveiled, CitizenGO's campaign reached new heights. Our **Geneva team** delivered our petition with nearly **half a million signatures** directly to the WHO, making it clear that people from all walks of life were paying attention.





“It was incredible to see the momentum building,” said Sebastian Lukomski, who was putting in day and night to investigate the text and the negotiations of the treaty. **Every day, thousands more people were signing the petition, sharing the message, and getting involved. It became clear that this was something people cared deeply about.**



The UNGA: A Global Chess Match

As summer came, the battle entered a new phase. The treaty was now in its draft stages, and governments were actively weighing in. The fight had become a global chess match, with CitizenGO at the forefront.

The **United Nations General Assembly (UNGA)** in New York was the next critical front. On **September 20, 2023**, CitizenGO made its mark on the global stage once again. With mobile billboards and banners circling the UN headquarters, we boldly declared: **“We will not let global organizations strip nations of their sovereignty.”** The voice of the people—our voice—was being heard.

By this time, CitizenGO had amassed over **1 million signatures**. The world’s eyes were on us, and we would not back down. Our movement was growing stronger by the day.



Berlin 2023: Expanding the Fight

October 2023 brought yet another milestone in our journey. As world leaders gathered in **Berlin** for the **World Health Summit**, CitizenGO was there. Though denied entry, our activists made their presence known with 850,000+ signatures: we would not allow freedoms to be traded away.

The media spotlight grew brighter. People were waking up to the reality that the Pandemic Treaty wasn't about public health—it was about **power** and who holds it.



2023-2024: A Movement Grows Stronger

By December 2023, the 7th Intergovernmental Negotiating Body met in Geneva to negotiate the Pandemic Treaty. Our message was as clear as ever:

We will not let the unelected WHO infringe on our fundamental freedoms and individual health choices!



In January 2024, CitizenGO took the fight to the global elite at the **54th World Economic Forum** in Davos.

We knew that behind the scenes, world leaders were discussing the WHO Pandemic Treaty. Once again, we made it clear that the people would not be silent.



By February, the WHO's push to finalize the treaty had intensified. A special **marathon meeting** in Geneva on February 19 drew CitizenGO's full attention. We rallied our supporters, and protests erupted outside the **UN and WHO** headquarters. Our message was simple and strong: we would not allow the WHO to dictate our future.



In both 2023 and 2024, **we also took our fight to the UN Human Rights Council**, making it clear in our interventions that the WHO Pandemic Treaty wasn't just about health—it was a direct threat to our fundamental freedoms. Under the guise of public health, this treaty sought to chip away at civil liberties and silence free speech. We stood firm, voicing the concerns of millions who refused to let unelected global bodies decide the future of our rights and freedoms.



Fact Box

- CitizenGO had collected over 2.5 million signatures opposing the WHO Pandemic Treaty.
- Concerned people from 20+ countries participated in CitizenGO's protests and awareness campaigns.
- The movement gained traction, leading multiple governments to reconsider their support for the treaty.

May 2024: The “Freedom Bus” Makes History

In May 2024, CitizenGO took its most audacious action yet. During the 77th World Health Assembly, our Freedom Bus became the symbol of resistance. Rolling through the streets of Geneva with bold messages advocating for personal freedom and national sovereignty, the Freedom Bus quickly captured the world’s attention.



Even as the **UN Security Office** sent police to investigate our bus, accusing it of spreading “propaganda,” we remained undeterred. With **2.5 million signatures** collected, and protests continuing outside WHO headquarters, our resolve had never been stronger.





Ren Minghui, the former Assistant Director-General for Communicable and Non-Communicable Diseases at the WHO, took to social media to criticize the bus, further fueling the debate and drawing even more attention to CitizenGO's campaign.



A Victory for the People

Meanwhile, inside the World Health Assembly, CitizenGO's efforts and the growing resistance from governments led to a **major breakthrough**. On June 1, 2024, the WHO announced a decision to extend treaty negotiations for another year, pushing the final decision to the 2025 World Health Assembly.

This extension was **a significant victory for CitizenGO and its supporters**. It not only bought valuable time to rally further opposition but also demonstrated that grassroots efforts could challenge and delay decisions at the highest levels of global governance.

CitizenGO, along with **millions of supporters**, is watching closely. We already proved in **May 2024** that we could **halt their agenda**—and now, we're ready to do it again. **We stopped them once, and we can stop them again.** This is **our chance** to send a powerful message: **“You don't get to decide on our health, our children's health, or our freedom.”**

The Hidden Threat: IHR Amendments

On the same day the Pandemic Treaty was delayed, the IHR Amendments were quietly passed, granting the WHO unilateral power to declare global health emergencies and impose restrictions. Adopted without a proper vote and with only a third of member states present, the process was highly questionable.

CitizenGO is now campaigning for governments to reject these amendments before they take effect in 10 months. This fight is as crucial as the battle against the Pandemic Treaty.
